# PDHPE Healthy, Safe and Active Lifestyles

Eating a balanced diet is one way we need to take care of our bodies. What else do we need to do to stay healthy? That's right we need to exercise and we need to look after our hygiene. This week we will look at personal hygiene routines.

Mindful eating

Eating is something that is rarely done mindfully by young people or adults. Mindful eating is a valuable task to slow down the mind and become more focused on the present.

Choose a food you love to eat Maybe a piece of your favourite fruit.

Sit somewhere comfortable and quiet. Close your eyes and hold the food you have chosen in your hand.

What shape is the food? Is it heavy or light?

Slowly breathe in through your nose and count 1, 2, 3 in your head. Hold the breath for 1, 2, 3. Slowly breathe out through your mouth and count 1, 2, 3 in your head. Hold the food up to your nose and take a deep breath in and count 1, 2, 3 in your head.

What does the food smell like?
How does the food make you feel?

Take a small bite and keep the food on your tongue for a moment.

What does the food feel like

		on your tongue? What can you taste?
		Swallow the food.
		What did the food taste like? Was it sweet or salty or bitter? What did the food feel like as it went down your throat?
		Try these steps again with bigger or smaller bites and ask the same questions. Keep going until you finish the food.
