# Kindergarten Enrolment 2023

Kindergarten Enrolments for 2023 are now being accepted. Please contact our school office between 8.30am and 3.00pm Monday to Friday to collect the enrolment forms or enrol online through the school website. Completed application forms should be returned to the school office together with:

- Child's Birth Certificate or identity documents
- Proof of child's address such as current council rates notice, lease agreement and electricity bill. Schools that are above or near their local enrolment buffer will use the Department's 100-point residential address check.
- Immunisation history statement from the Medicare website
- Any family law or other relevant court orders, if applicable
- If your child has health, disability or other support needs you will need to provide copies of medical/healthcare or emergency action plans and evidence of any disability and learning and support plans.

Orientation Days will be held in Term 4 on Tuesday the 25<sup>th</sup> October, 1<sup>st</sup> November and the 8<sup>th</sup> November 2022. The parent information session will be held on Tuesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2022.


