We have had two afternoon teas in our Preschool where families could meet the coordinators of the program and find out information about their services. ### Student Attendance Congratulations

We are happy to announce that we received congratulations from the Penrith School Director for an improved attendance rate for the first half of this term. Our attendance rate was at 89.4% which is good, but we are aiming to be over the 90%. Thank you to all our families who are working to improve their child's attendance, we will continue to speak with families either by phone or email/letter to follow up any attendance concerns. Beginning this term we will also be celebrating all our students with a 95% to 100% attendance rate, each term, with a special letter home to parents and attendance award.



## Olympian Visit and Blue week

I reported in our last newsletter that Olympian Noemie Fox, Gold Medallist form the Paris Olympics, would be visiting the school on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025 to speak to Year 4, 5 and 6 students. We have been informed that she is now unable to come, and in her place we will have Olympian Nathan Katz who represented Australia in judo. We are very excited to have an Olympian to come and talk with our students.

## **Disability Awareness Week**

Autism Awareness is something we do each year to raise awareness and education around Autism, as we have so many students in our Special Education classes and our Mainstream classes. We have also had special days which are recognised to help continue raising awareness about different medical conditions that affect some of our students.

We have decided this year to combine some of these days and have a Disability Awareness Week. Each day we will highlight some of the current medical conditions that are affecting students here at Kingswood South. It is hoped with raising awareness and education we can continue to support students with empathy, understanding and knowledge on how to treat each other with respect.


#### How to set up your Flexischools account

Simply <u>download the Flexischools App</u> from the Apple or Google stores and follow the prompts to create an account.

You can also signup through the Flexischools website flexischools.com.au



If you already have a Flexischools account you can simply add a new student to your existing account.



#### 1. Download the app

The Flexischools app is the easiest way to place online lunch orders, buy school uniforms, and receive instant notifications from your school.







#### 2. Register

- Open the Flexischools App and click 'Register'.
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link and follow the registration process.



#### 3. Log in to your Flexischools account and enter your child's details

- Select the 'Profile' icon on the navigation bar.
- Under 'Students', click 'Add new'.
- Enter your child's name, school, year level, and class.
- Click 'submit'.

#### How to order

- Click the 'Order Food' button at the top of the home page.
- Select which student you would like to place the order for.
- Choose which service, and date you would like to place the order for.
- Make your selections by adding items
- Click "View Order", then "Checkout & Pay"

Tip: Pay-as-you-go for each order, or top-up your Flexischools Wallet.

#### Student Login

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

#### Cancelling your order

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

#### Fee & Charges

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App. This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to view instructions.
