## **Mobileyes**

Mobileyes has partnered with us to bring its fully equipped Mobile Optometry Clinic and AHPRA registered optometrists to our school to conduct eye check-ups.

The comprehensive eye check-up program is bulk billed (no gap) to Medicare. The examination includes:

- Clarity of vision assessment for distance and near
- Internal and external eye health assessment
- Eye co-ordination, binocular vision, depth perception and colour vision assessment
- Testing Report sent to parents

One in five Australian children suffers from an undetected vision problem or requires ongoing assessment. Good vision is important for a child's educational, behavioural and social development; which helps them reach their full learning potential. Many children continue to experience undetected and unnecessary vision problems and often they assume that how they see is normal. If you would like your child to undertake this great service at our school, please sign and return the consent form that has been sent out through the Parent Portal.

## **Student Attendance**

At the end of the term, we will be awarding Attendance Awards to students who manage to be here at school 90% or more for Term 2. We have made a great start to Term 2 with only a few attendance letters going home to families. We are happy to announce that our Term 1 attendance was up on the previous year. In Term 1 last year we were at 88.6% for attendance and this year our Term 1 attendance percentage was 91.6%. Thank you to our families who are supporting by getting your children to school every day. With increased attendance students can achieve more with their learning, and connect daily with their friend, which improves their overall wellbeing. The Penrith School Director was also very pleased with our results and asked me to forward her congratulations to the school community.

A reminder as we have many families that are planning overseas holidays and that you must apply for exemption. The department hopes that families try to plan during the school holidays rather than taking time off school during the term.

As we look ahead to the remainder of the school year, I'd like to remind our school community that we are here to work with you to support your child to thrive. We know that families experience a variety of challenging circumstances, and we are committed to working with you to address any barriers to regular attendance.

If your child is feeling anxious about coming to school and you need support, please reach out to your child's teacher or to me directly. There are also helpful resources for parents and carers on the NSW Department of Education website.

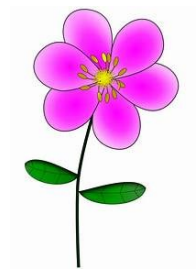

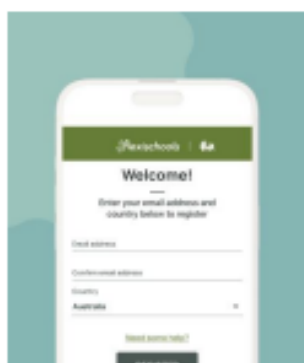
## How to set up your Flexischools account

Simply [download the Flexischools App](#) from the Apple or Google stores and follow the prompts to create an account.

You can also signup through the Flexischools website [flexischools.com.au](https://flexischools.com.au)

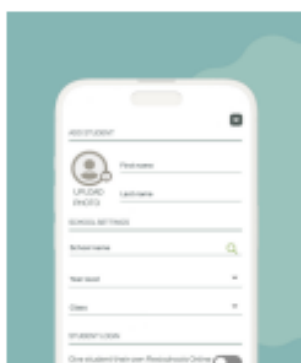


If you already have a Flexischools account you can simply add a new student to your existing account.



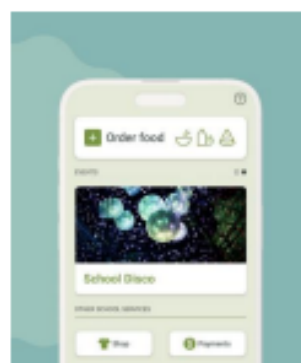
### 1. Download the app

The Flexischools app is the easiest way to place online lunch orders, buy school uniforms, and receive instant notifications from your school.



### 2. Register

- Open the Flexischools App and click 'Register'.
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link and follow the registration process.



### 3. Log in to your Flexischools account and enter your child's details

- Select the 'Profile' icon on the navigation bar.
- Under 'Students', click 'Add new'.
- Enter your child's name, school, year level, and class.
- Click 'submit'.



## **How to order**

- Click the 'Order Food' button at the top of the home page.
- Select which student you would like to place the order for.
- Choose which service, and date you would like to place the order for.
- Make your selections by adding items
- Click "View Order", then "Checkout & Pay"

Tip: Pay-as-you-go for each order, or top-up your Flexischools Wallet.

## **Student Login**

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

## **Cancelling your order**

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

## **Fee & Charges**

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App. This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to [view instructions](#).
