Athletics Carnival

The Athletics Carnival will take place on **Monday 30th June 2025** at Harold Corr Oval, Herbert Street Cambridge Park. This is a brand new, state of the art, synthetic athletics track and will provide our students with a different experience to that of the traditional grass track.

All Stage 2 and 3 students are expected to attend. All Year 2 children who are born in 2017 are also eligible to attend the carnival. The cost for the bus is \$15 per student.

All students are to travel to the carnival on the bus, which will be departing shortly after 9am. If you are attending the carnival, you may take your child home with you at the completion of the carnival at 2.20pm. Students must be signed out with their classroom teacher. If you have organised for another parent to collect your child, you will need to have this in writing for the classroom teacher either before or on the day of the event.

Please ensure your child is dressed suitably for the carnival wearing house colours or the school sports uniform, including their school hat and suitable footwear. It is recommended that students bring warm clothing for changeable weather. All children will need to bring sufficient healthy food and drink for the carnival. Sunblock and extra water bottles are recommended.

NAIDOC Cup

On Friday 27th June 2025 our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students will be participating in a friendly sports competition, building connections, and learning about the cultural history of NAIDOC Week. This year's theme "The Next Generation: Strength, Vision & Legacy" emphasises unity, resilience and the richness of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures. The NAIDOC Cup will provide a fantastic opportunity for our students. Thank you to Mrs Wrona and Mrs Hardie-Grant who have organised our student's participation.

Winter Chills

Now that winter is here, please make sure your child leaves home each morning with appropriate cold weather gear, including a jumper and or jacket. All students will be making a card and writing to someone they care about. Students will then give the card to the person they have written to, increasing the ripple effect of kindness.

NSW Public Schools Student Survey - Years 3-6

PDHPE and Child Protection Lessons 2025

This year, students at KSPS will be involved in the mandatory subject Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE). Our school's PDHPE program covers a wide range of education matter, including relationships, drug use, human sexuality, child protection, fundamental movement skill development, safety and physical activity. Some of the content of the program deals with sensitive issues. The school recognises this, by teaching about these issues within the context of a developmentally appropriate program and by providing information to you about the program.

The school program aims to encourage students to make informed decisions about their lifestyle, taking into account the values of the family, culture and religion to which they belong.

PDHPE will be delivered in classrooms weekly throughout the course of the year. The school is required to inform parents and carers of the content of the curriculum as it deals with sensitive issues. If you have any issues or concerns, please contact the school.

Simply <u>download the Flexischools App</u> from the Apple or Google stores and follow the prompts to create an account.





Student Login

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

Cancelling your order

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

Fee & Charges

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App. This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to <u>view instructions</u>.
