Stage One students will be taking part in an excursion to **The Australian Pioneer Village** on **Wednesday 8th May 2024**. The excursion has been planned to supplement and enhance student learning in HSIE.

At the excursion, students will be met by the organisers who will present an engaging day in what Australia was like in the 1800s. Stepping back in time, the village will transport our young learners to an era where they could witness firsthand the daily life of early Australian settlers. The quaint, heritage buildings, complete with their rustic charm, will showcase the simplicity and resourcefulness of colonial architecture. Students will be able to gain insights into the domestic tasks that were integral to the pioneers' survival.
