## 100 Days of Learning School Fun Run

Dear Parents and Carers,

**Details:** We are holding a School Fun Run to celebrate our 100<sup>th</sup> Day of Learning. From today we launch our major school fundraiser for 2024. The more money we raise the more we can provide for the students through vital school projects and initiatives. We're reaching out to all our amazing families to join forces and make this a success.

**Classes involved:** Preschool & Early Intervention, Kindy to Year 6 (ALL STUDENTS)

**When:** Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2024

**Note:** Students will be covered in an explosion of colour. This coloured powder is made of high-quality corn starch and permitted food colours. Safety data sheet is available upon request. Parents will be invited to join us on the day to watch your children run, more details will be provided closer to the date.

**What to wear:** WHITE sun safe shirt and closed in shoes.

**How to fundraise:** Fundraising is simple – all you need to do is:

1. Create an online profile at <https://www.schoolfunrun.com.au>,
2. Set your child's goal
3. Share with family and friends via social media, email or text message.
4. Remember to share the link at least once per week to refresh who visits your page!

**All fundraising is to be through the <https://www.schoolfunrun.com.au> portal, no cash or Sentral donations can be accepted. Follow the instructions in your child's sponsorship booklet to create a cybersafe, online profile. At the end of the fundraiser students will be able to order prizes directly through the portal based on their donations received.**

**Note:** Last day for donations will be Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Prize selection will open Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July and close on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

**INCENTIVES to Fundraise each week:**

1. Week 1 – Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> June: All students with a registered profile that has raised \$10 will go into a draw to win a bag of SLIME. Additionally, the class with the highest number of profiles will receive an icy pole for each fundraising student!
2. Week 2 – Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> June: All students that have raised \$50 or more will go into a draw to win an AQUA BLASTER!

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Thank you in advance for your participation and get ready for a BLAST OF COLOUR to celebrate our 100<sup>th</sup> day of learning! Happy fundraising!

All students will be participating in the FUN RUN, however please only return this note if you **DO NOT** wish for your child to participate in the colour explosion.

All measures have been taken to ensure that this event is safe for all students. The staff will do their best to throw the powder at the torso, however wind and other factors can cause the powder to protrude on the face.

The colour powder used in the event is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly consisting of 98% corn starch and 2% food colouring. It will likely washout of your child's clothing, however we recommend that your child wears a plain white shirt that you don't mind being coloured. That's what the event is all about!

Based on the toxicology profiles of the powders used, their concentrations in the formulation and the mode of use, the colour powder is considered safe for use. *Students with asthma are required to wear a bandana or face mask for this activity.* Should you wish to view the ingredient listings and toxicology risk assessment of the powder, please see the staff in the Administration Office.

In accordance with our discipline policy, if your child is on Orange Level, he / she will not be able to attend.
