KSPS 3-6 Athletics Carnival

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Athletics Carnival will take place on **Monday 17th June, 2024** at Harold Corr Oval, Herbert Street Cambridge Park. This is a brand new, state of the art, synthetic athletics track and will provide our students with a different experience to that of the traditional grass track.

All Stage 2 and 3 students are expected to attend.

All Year 2 children who are born in 2016 are also eligible to attend the carnival.

The cost for the bus is \$10 per student. Our P&C have kindly donated to help lower the cost of this activity.

All students are to travel to the carnival on the bus, which will be departing shortly after 9am.

Parents are welcome to join us on the day and will be able to sit in an allocated area to spectate. Also, a reminder that in accordance with DET regulations this is a non-smoking event and there are no pets allowed at the field. If you are attending the carnival, you may take your child home with you at the completion of the carnival at 2.20pm. Students should be signed out with their classroom teacher. If you have organised for another parent to collect your child, you will need to have this in writing to the classroom teacher either before or on the day of the event.

Please ensure your child is dressed suitably for the carnival wearing house colours or the school sports uniform, including their school hat and suitable footwear. It is recommended that students bring warm clothing for changeable weather. All children will need to bring sufficient healthy food and drink for the carnival. Sunblock and extra water bottles are recommended.

Canteen facilities will be available on the day and are being run by Werrington Little Athletics Club as the oval is their home ground.

High jump will not be held at KSPS. If your child participates in high jump in Little Athletics you are welcome to submit their registered jump height with the office staff before the Athletics Carnival on the 17th June. If their height is of qualifying level we will enter them for possible selection at the Zone Athletics Carnival.

In accordance with our discipline policy, if your child is on Orange Level, they will not be able to attend and will remain at school.

Payments and permission can be given through the Sentral Parent Portal. There is no need to return the note if this option is chosen. Please contact the office if you do not use Sentral Parent Portal and need access.

Payments can also be made in the school office by Cash and EFTPOS. All payments made through the office must be in a clearly marked envelope with child's name, class and activity. All payments and permissions are to be completed **no later than Monday 10th June 2024**. If you need to make payment arrangements, please contact the office before this date.

Personal injury statement

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region, state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or loss of the use of certain prescribed parts of the body.
