Dear Parents and Carers.

This year's Market Day event will be held on **Thursday, 21st November** 2024, between 12:00 pm and 1:15pm. Parents and carers are invited to attend with their children during this time. Students are welcome to wear **Mufti** on this day. Market Day is one of Year Six students' major fundraising initiatives and Stage 3 will be running a variety of stalls, including:

- Target and sports skills activities
- Water activities
- Snacks and sweets

- Novelty Stalls
- Refreshment stalls
- Haunted House
- Face Painting

Students from K-6 will be required to purchase tokens to access the activities, novelties and food stalls.

Tokens are priced at one dollar each and can be purchased in cards of \$5 or \$10. Most stalls will charge between one and two tokens. To purchase tokens for your child, please fill out the slip attached and return to the school office with your payment by Monday 18th November.

All payments and permission need to be received by Monday 18th November. Any cash payments must be in a clearly marked envelope with child's name, class and amount of tokens, and paid to the office no later than **Monday 18th November.** Token Cards will also be available for purchase on the day, during the event.

Donations for this event are still needed and will be appreciated. Each student donating will receive a thank you token for their donations, which can be used at any of the wonderful stalls available on the day. Please bring any donations to the office.

Personal injury statement

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region, state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or loss of the use of certain prescribed parts of the body.
