PACIFIC CHAMPIONSHIPS SCHOOL GALA DAY 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

There is an exciting opportunity coming up next month for our stage 3 students. We have been offered limited places to attend the Pacific Championships School Gala Day. All 8 full squad teams, including the Kangaroos, Jillaroos, Kiwis, Ferns, Tonga XIII, and PNG Orchids will be there. The students will have the opportunity to meet players from these squads, participate in clinics, league tag games, and enjoy cultural demonstrations and workshops representing each nation.

Travel: Bus

Cost: \$20

Venue: Old Salesyard Reserve – 76 Gladstone Street, North Parramatta

We have a maximum of 60 places for Stage 3 students on this excursion. The first 60 students to give permission and make payment will be given a place and any further students give permission after that will be placed on a waiting list. All payments and permission need to be received by Friday 1st November.

All children will need to bring sufficient healthy food and drink for the gala day. Sunblock and extra water bottles are recommended.

In accordance with our discipline policy, if your child is on Orange Level, they will not be able to attend and will remain at school.

Personal injury statement

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region, state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or loss of the use of certain prescribed parts of the body.
