#### **YEAR SIX FAREWELL 2024**

Dear Parents and Carers.

The 2024 Year 6 Farewell will be held at Emu Sports Club on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2024 starting at 6:00pm and concluding at 9:30pm. The event consists of the presentation of graduation certificates, dinner, speeches, cake cutting ceremony and dancing. The cost will be approximately \$15.00. Emu Sports Club is located at 1 Leonay Parade, Leonay NSW 2750.

- \* Parents, families, and friends will be allowed to visit and wait outside the venue to view students arriving. Students may begin arriving from 6pm. Upon drop off, students will be able to take some photos in the area outside the function room with family and friends before entering the function room to be seated at their table by 6.30pm.
- \* Vehicles dropping off students may drive up to the designated drop off point inside the car park, this will be sign posted and our teachers will be assisting entry and exit of the car park. After dropping off students, cars will need to leave the drop off area and park in the car park facility.
- \* At 6.30pm parents/carers will be able to access the function room and stand towards the back of the room. We will begin proceedings with a short presentation of graduation certificates. We encourage parents to stay for this ceremony and then invite parents to leave to allow for the farewell celebrations to begin.
- \* Please note, KSPS staff will be taking photos on the night of all events, and these will be shared with students using the Google Drive accessed via students' Department of Education log in. Students do not need to bring mobile phones for camera purposes.
- \* At the conclusion of the event, parents are encouraged to arrive by 9.15pm to re-enter the function room and stand towards the back of the room. A short photo slide presentation will then be shared showcasing the many events the graduating students have shared at KSPS.

For a Year Six student to attend the whole event they must:

- 1. Follow all school and class rules and expectations during the remainder of Term Four
- 2. Not be on orange level the week before and the week of the Farewell
- 3. Not be suspended at the time of the Farewell

Whilst attending the Farewell the students need to:

- 1. Remain in the allocated Venue Room
- 2. Do not approach the bar. Ask a teacher if they need their drinks refilled.
- 3. Be respectful at all times to teachers and venue staff
- 4. Dress appropriately for a semi- formal event (this will be discussed at school in more detail with the students)

If permission is completed through the Sentral Parent Portal, this note does not need to be returned. Please complete the slip attached and return to the school office by Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2024.
