KSPS Athletics Carnival

Dear Parents and Carers

The Athletics Carnival will take place on **Monday 30th June, 2025** at Harold Corr Oval, Herbert Street Cambridge Park. This is a brand new, state of the art, synthetic athletics track and will provide our students with a different experience to that of the traditional grass track.

All Stage 2 and 3 students are expected to attend.

All Year 2 children who are born in 2017 are also eligible to attend the carnival.

The cost for the bus is \$15 per student.

All students are to travel to the carnival on the bus, which will be departing shortly after 9am. If you are attending the carnival, you may take your child home with you at the completion of the carnival at 2.20pm. Students must be signed out with their classroom teacher. If you have organised for another parent to collect your child, you will need to have this in writing to the classroom teacher either before or on the day of the event.

Please ensure your child is dressed suitably for the carnival wearing house colours or the school sports uniform, including their school hat and suitable footwear. It is recommended that students bring warm clothing for changeable weather. All children will need to bring sufficient healthy food and drink for the carnival. Sunblock and extra water bottles are recommended.

All students are expected to compete on the day, making an attempt at each rotation event. House points will be awarded for participation as well as finishing within the top three places in each event. House points will also be awarded for best dressed and house spirit across the day.

Students will rotate through the following events in their ages groups:

100m sprint - students place in each age group (8, 9, 10, 11, 12)

200m sprint - students place in each age group (8, 9, 10, 11, 12)

Long jump - students place in JUNIOR (8,9,10), 11 YEARS, and SENIOR (12,13) age groups

Discus - students place in JUNIOR (8,9,10), 11 YEARS, and SENIOR (12,13) age groups

Shot put - students place in JUNIOR (8,9,10), 11 YEARS, and SENIOR (12,13) age groups

These events will be offered on an optional basis:

800m run - students place in JUNIOR (8,9,10), 11 YEARS, and SENIOR (12,13) age groups

1500m run - students place in JUNIOR (8,9,10), 11 YEARS, and SENIOR (12,13) age groups

High jump - students place in JUNIOR (8,9,10), 11 YEARS, and SENIOR (12,13) age groups

Please note: Entry into all Zone events is by invitation based on qualifying times and distances.

If your child wishes to compete in the 800m run, please indicate this when giving permission. These students will be placed on the first bus to the venue and this event will be run first before the carnival begins.

Canteen facilities will be available on the day and are being run by Werrington Little Athletics Club as the oval is their home ground.

Please fill out the permission slip attached and return to the school office with your payment. Payment can be made by cash to the office or online through Sentral. Any cash payments must be in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name, class and activity, and paid to the office no later than **Wednesday 25th June 2025**. If you need to make payment arrangements, please contact the office before this date.

Parents are welcome to join us on the day and will be able to sit in an allocated area to spectate.

A reminder that in accordance with DET regulations this is a non-smoking event and there are no pets allowed at the field.

If you are able to assist on the day of the carnival as an official, please answer in Sentral or fill out the volunteer slip on the following page.

Personal injury statement


In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region, state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or loss of the use of certain prescribed parts of the body.
