changes. I have included a photo for parents.

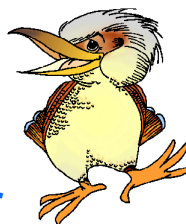

Clothing bags will be sent home to families soon and need to be returned to school NO LATER THAN Wednesday 13th June, 2018.

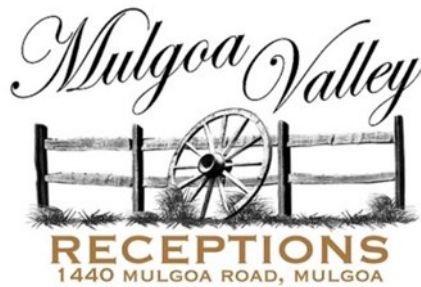
So start gathering those outgrown items of clothing now.
